Important Reminder for Commercial Apprentices Enrolled in CIGNA HMO: If you are a WECA Commercial apprentice enrolled with a CIGNA HMO health plan, please remember that all services must be coordinated through your Primary Care Physician (PCP). If you are a newly insured apprentice and you did not choose a Primary Care Physician at the time of your enrollment, the CIGNA HMO will assign you a PCP based on your geographic location.
