State Court Denies Request to De-Publish Ruling on Scope of Work for Electricians vs. Laborers: The

California Supreme Court has rejected calls to overturn an Appeals Court ruling that virtually all work performed by a C-10 contractor must be performed by a certified electrician or registered electrician trainee, and that no work covered by the NEC can be performed by a laborer.
